



**BYLAW No. 1609-12
of the
TOWN OF PINCHER CREEK**

**A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF PINCHER CREEK,
IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA,
FOR THE PURPOSE OF REPEALING
BYLAW #1239, ROAD CLOSURE**

PURSUANT to Section 191(1) of the Municipal Government Act, Revised Statutes of Alberta 2000 Chapter M-26, and amendments thereto, the power to pass a bylaw under this or any other enactment includes a power to amend or repeal the bylaw.

WHEREAS the Council for the Town of Pincher Creek in the Province of Alberta considers it necessary to repeal Bylaw #1239, which closed the following described public road:

THAT portion of the road allowance, South of the SW ¼ of Section 26 in Township 6, Range 30, West of the 4th Meridian to the West of the Easterly production of Mill Avenue, on Plan 4318-L

Containing 0.67 acres more or less.
Excepting thereout all mines and minerals.
As illustrated on the map attached as Schedule "A"
(Hereinafter referred to as '*said road*')

WHEREAS the Council for the Town of Pincher Creek deems it necessary to re-open *said road* for public travel; and

WHEREAS there are service lines located under *said road*, and;

WHEREAS the *said road* is the only access to property owned by the Town of Pincher Creek; and

NOW THEREFORE pursuant to the provisions of the Municipal Government Act, it is hereby enacted by the Council of the Town of Pincher Creek as follows:

1. That Bylaw #1239 and amendments thereto are hereby repealed.
2. This bylaw comes into force and effect upon third and final reading thereof.


