<b>Title:           ADVERTISING FOR PUBLIC HEARINGS</b>		

### **Purpose**

The Town of Pincher Creek will provide guidelines for the advertising of Public Hearings on bylaws pursuant to The Municipal Government Act.

### **1.    Definitions**

- 1.1    MUNICIPAL GOVERNMENT ACT means the Municipal Government Act, Chapter M.26.1, 1994 and amendments thereto.
- 1.2    LAND USE BYLAW means a bylaw of the Town of Pincher Creek passed as a land use bylaw in accordance with the Municipal Government Act, Section 640 and includes a bylaw under Section 3 of the Historical Resources Act.
- 1.3    AREA REDEVELOPMENT PLAN means a plan adopted by the Town of Pincher Creek as an Area Redevelopment Plan pursuant to the Municipal Government Act.
- 1.4    GENERAL MUNICIPAL PLAN means a plan adopted by the Town of Pincher Creek as a General Municipal Plan pursuant to the Municipal Government Act.
- 1.5    AREA STRUCTURE PLAN means a plan adopted by the Town of Pincher Creek as an Area Structure Plan pursuant to the Municipal Government Act.
- 1.6    AMENDING BYLAW means an amending bylaw for sections 1.2 to 1.5.
- 1.7    REPEALING BYLAW means a repealing bylaw for section 1.2 to 1.5

**2. Responsibilities**

**2.1 Director of Community Services**

Pursuant to the Municipal Government Act, Section 606:

- 2.1.1 Direct the publication of a notice at least once a week for two consecutive weeks of the same newspaper in Pincher Creek, of proposed bylaws dealing with the Land Use Bylaw, Area Redevelopment Plan, Area Structure Plan or General Municipal Plan or amendments thereto or bylaws repealing any the above.
- 2.1.2 Ensure that the notice is mailed or delivered to every residence in the area to which the proposed bylaw, Area Redevelopment Plan, Area Structure Plan or General Municipal Plan or amendments thereto relates, or in which the meeting or hearing is to be held.
- 2.1.3 Ensure the notice of public hearing or meeting is advertised at least five (5) days before the public hearing or meeting.
