



**BYLAW No. 1612-12
Of the
TOWN OF PINCHER CREEK**

**A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF PINCHER CREEK,
IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA,
FOR THE PURPOSE OF REPEALING BY-LAW #1239-A**

PURSUANT to Section 191(1) of the Municipal Government Act, Revised Statutes of Alberta 2000 Chapter M-26, and amendments thereto, the power to pass a bylaw under this or any other enactment includes a power to amend or repeal the bylaw.

WHEREAS the Council for the Town of Pincher Creek in the Province of Alberta considers it necessary to repeal BY-LAW #1239-A, which closed the following described public road:

“ALL THAT portion of Statutory Road Allowance adjoining the south boundary of the South West quarter of Section Twenty-six (26), Township Six (6), Range Thirty (30), West of the Fourth (4) Meridian which lies east of the production northerly across said Road Allowance of the E. Limit of road as shown on plan 4318-L and lies west of the west limit of road as shown on Plan 442-JK containing Two and forty-one hundredths (2.41) acres more or less.

Excepting thereout all mines and minerals.”

As illustrated on the map attached as Schedule “A”
(Hereinafter referred to as ‘*said road*’)

WHEREAS the Council for the Town of Pincher Creek deems it necessary to re-open *said road* for public travel; and


WHEREAS there are service lines located under *said road*, and;

WHEREAS the *said road* is the only access to property owned by the Town of Pincher Creek; and

NOW THEREFORE pursuant to the provisions of the Municipal Government Act, it is hereby enacted by the Council of the Town of Pincher Creek as follows:

1. That BY-LAW #1239-A and amendments thereto are hereby repealed.
2. This bylaw comes into force and effect upon third and final reading thereof.
