DEPARTMENTAL OVERVIEW

The third Quarter of 2018 has been a busy one. New sidewalk projects are well under way; as well as Asphalt patching, painting curbs and crosswalk lines to name a few.

Sage Creek Fire kept us on our toes for the Month of August, with the Director of Operations wearing dual hats as the Director of Emergency Management. The department pulled together to pick up in the Director of Operations absence, while he attended to the Emergency Command Center.

Administratively, the third quarter saw the writing of 30 letters and 13 requests for decisions. Administration also assisted in Emergency management support.

The Water Treatment plant has had some pumps fail and staff have been working tirelessly on repairing these. Water Distribution upgrades are almost complete on Thistle Crescent and Albert Avenue will commence in October.

The Operations Department has also been installing bus route signs and Bus shelters at various locations around town in anticipation of the Transit bus being operational.

Staff participated in the annual Blue Weed Blitz in July. August saw a busy fair and rodeo weekend, the public works department helped with parade route barricades, garbage can set up and take down.

Late August saw our Summer Staff head back to school, lots was accomplished this Summer with the extra help. The Operations Department is shifting gears and starting to prepare equipment for the winter.
