

## BYLAW No. 1395-13 of the TOWN OF PINCHER CREEK

## A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF PINCHER CREEK, IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, TO ESTABLISH A PENALTY ON UNPAID CURRENT TAXES AND UNPAID ARREARS TAXES

WHEREAS, pursuant to sections 344, 345 and 346 of the Municipal Government Act, being Chapter M-26 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta 2000, and amendments thereto, a municipality has the authority to pass a bylaw imposing penalties on unpaid current and arrears taxes.

**NOW THEREFORE**, pursuant to the provisions of the Municipal Government Act, it is hereby enacted by the Council of the Town of Pincher Creek as follows:

- 1. That any taxes levied due and payable in the current year remain unpaid by July 1 of that year, shall by way of penalty, an amount equal to twelve percent (12%) of the amount due, be added to and form part of the unpaid taxes.
- 2. That any remaining unpaid taxes after December 31 of the year, shall by way of penalty, an amount equal to ten percent (10%) of the amount due, be added on the first day of January, and each succeeding year thereafter so long as the arrears remain unpaid, and each penalty be added to and form part of the unpaid taxes.
- 3. That Bylaw #1395 and #1389 are hereby repealed.
- 4. This bylaw comes into force and effect upon third and final reading thereof.
