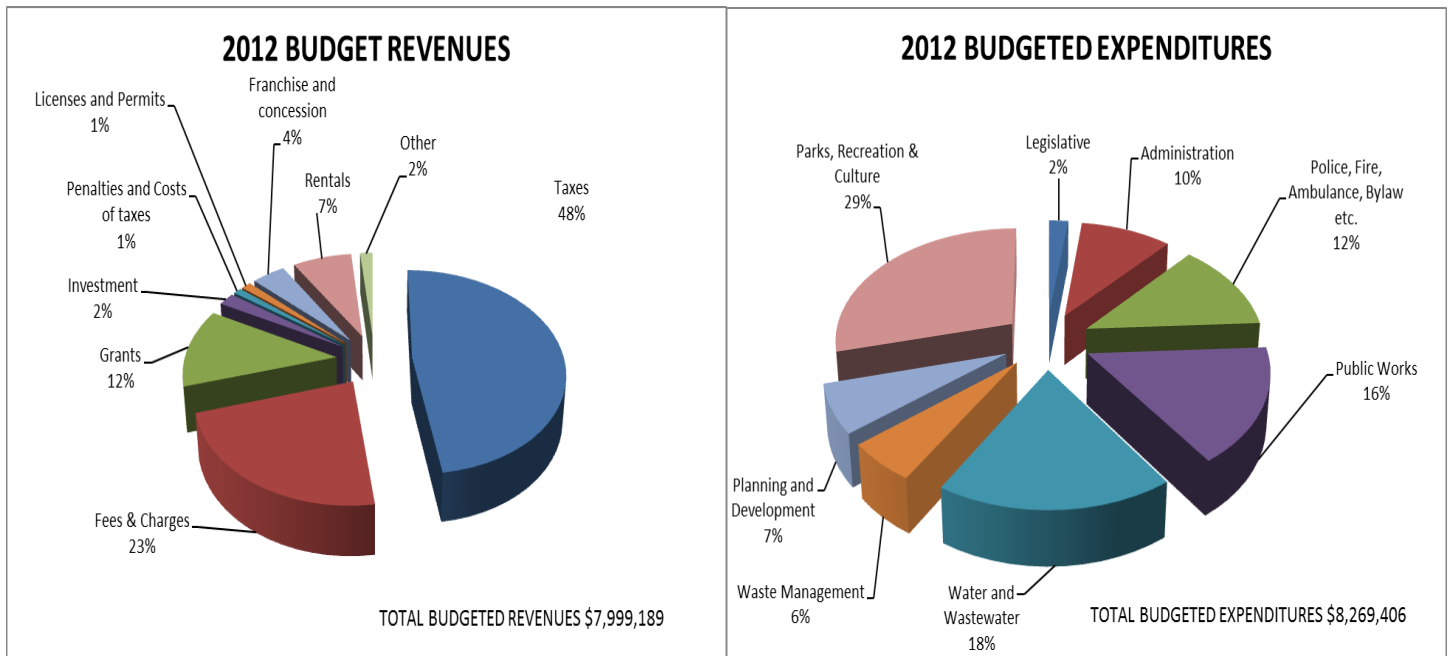

TAX INSTALLMENT PAYMENT PROGRAM OR DIRECT ELECTRONIC FUNDS TRANSFER

T.I.P.P. is an optional monthly tax installment payment plan by which taxpayers may make consecutive monthly payments for taxes rather than one single tax payment.

D.E.F.T. is an optional bi-monthly payment for the full amount of bi-monthly utility billing.

Regular payments are made by an automatic electronic funds transfer from your bank account directly to the Town of Pincher Creek account.

T.I.P.P. payments start January 5th each year and are made on the fifth day of every month thereafter. Each monthly payment for the months of January to June shall be equal to 1/12 of the most recent annual tax levy. Each monthly payment for the months of July to December shall be equal to 1/12 of the taxes payable for the current year.

Provided regular monthly payments are made, penalties for late payment of taxes will not apply to any tax account included under T.I.P.P. Late payment interest and possible service disconnects will not apply to utility accounts included under D.E.F.T.

2012 BUSINESS LICENSES

Just a reminder that your 2012 Business License is due in January.

The annual fee for a business or home occupation is \$125.00. The Alberta Southwest Regional License is also available for an additional \$80.

The regional license covers Cardston County, the Municipality of the Crowsnest Pass, Cardston, Claresholm, Fort Macleod, Granum, MD of Willow Creek, MD of Pincher Creek, and the villages of Cowley and Glenwood.
